Neighbourhood gathering about themes out of 't Zand - Roosje Glaser & Stumbling Stones

Zandcafé | Thursday, 10 April

The first themed gathering of Zandcafé is about local Jewish residents during the Second World War. Discover the story of Roosje Glaser, a dance teacher who lived in 't Zand and survived several concentration camps. You will also learn more about the Stumbling Stones in memory of the many local Jewish residents who were murdered during the war.



Paul Glaser, Roosje Glaser's nephew, wrote a book about his aunt and will share her life story that evening. The **Struikelstenen 's-Hertogenbosch Foundation** will give a presentation about their efforts to honour and commemorate the deceased residents from the neighbourhood and city. We will be guests of the **L.W. Beekmanschool**. Many Jewish children at this school were persecuted. **The Paadjesmakers** will be present and selling their Stumbling Stones walking guide.

- 20h25 – 20h45 Break with the option to purchase a signed book by Paul Glaser
