Do you ever visit Sint Luciaplein? Would you like to see more greenery or more play areas? Do you have ideas for improvements? Fill in the questionnaire!

On behalf of Zandbewoners neighbourhood association, a group of **students from the HAS Green Academy** are conducting research into the use of Sint Luciaplein. In preparation for the redevelopment of the square, we want to gain a better understanding of how the square is used by local residents and why (certain parts of the square) are not used. We are also asking about safety throughout the neighbourhood, to gain an understanding of whether any areas are perceived as unsafe. **Your knowledge and experience are vital to this! Will you help us?**
